

# RODEO ENTRY LINE GUIDELINES –

## THE OFFICIAL ENTRY LINE OF THE MID-STATES RODEO ASSOCIATION

### *ENTRIES OPEN ON WEDNESDAY – 10 A.M. TO 6 P.M. CDT*

1. Be prepared to give name/s, card number, address, & status – member, local or non-member
2. Contestants may enter with 2 or 3 preferences – 1<sup>st</sup> perf over 2<sup>nd</sup>/ 2<sup>nd</sup> over 1<sup>st</sup>/ 1<sup>st</sup> over slack/ 2<sup>nd</sup> over draw out. Using a draw out as a 2<sup>nd</sup> preference does not guarantee a 1<sup>st</sup> preference. If there are multiple rodeos we will accept “get me to all”. But that does mean sometimes you will be back tracking and you must be willing to accept that depending on rodeos.
3. A contestant may enter using out if less than so many contestants. Example: out if less than 12 calf ropers.
4. A verification number will be given at the end of call in and call back. You are responsible for maintaining these numbers. If you do not have them and a problem arises at the rodeo performance you cannot post a bond.

### *TO EMAIL ENTRIES*

1. Go to rodeoentryline1@hotmail.com and send your rodeo entry. You will receive verification that your entry has been confirmed. Include all of the above items – the same as if you were entering by phone. Please enter Thursday 6 p.m. to Monday 11 a.m. before entries are taken on Wednesday.

### *CALL BACKS ON THURSDAY – 12 NOON TO 6 P.M. CDT*

1. Have name/s and rodeo/s that you entered on the prior day
2. Performance and total number of entries for each rodeo and contestant you entered will be given.
3. You will be given a verification number – your responsibility to maintain this number.

### *DAY SHEETS*

1. All rodeo performance official program sheet/s will be available by Friday noon on the website. (day after call backs)
2. For email entries your official verification can be the day sheets posted or you may call back on Thursday for a taped verification number.

### *BUDDY GROUPS*

1. Husband and wife count as one entry
2. Header and heeler team roping or mixed team roping partners count as one
3. The maximum buddy group we will accept is four.
4. A buddy group must be called in all at the same time on one phone call – no exceptions.

### *MEMBERSHIP STATUS*

1. Mid-State Rodeo Association members will receive first priority over locals and nonmembers. If the rodeo is co-approved, all association card holders will receive first priority over locals and non-members.
2. If one contestant in a buddy group is a non-member, he will drop all card holders to a non-member status in the preference list.
3. Locals have priority over non-members. Locals can only “local” one rodeo per season and then he will automatically become “non-member” status.

### *POSTING A BOND*

1. If you get to a rodeo and are not on the performance sheets as you believed you are suppose to be: turn in both verification numbers to the secretary and post a \$50 bond. Stock will be drawn for you and you will be able to compete. Monday morning we will read the tape and see what is correct. If the mistake is yours you forfeit the bond; which will be split ½ to contractor and ½ to Entry Line. If the mistake is the Entry Lines your bond is returned and we pay you ½ the bond and ½ to stock contractor. If you win money and the mistake was yours – the money is forfeited.
